August 12, 2019: Deadline to Withdraw from General Election Candidacy

- Candidates file in the Park County Clerk & Recorder's Office & within 5 days of filing, candidates must file the appropriate paperwork with the Commissioner of Political Practices in order for their names to appear on the ballot.

TOWN OF CLYDE PARK MAYOR

Filing fee is \$15.00

There is one position open for the Town of Clyde Park Mayor
The mayor serves a term of 4 years.

Mayor is paid \$120.00 / month

TOWN OF CLYDE PARK TOWN COUNCIL

Filing fee is \$15.00

There are two (3) positions open for the Town of Clyde Park Town Council

A town council member serves a term of 4 years.

Members are paid \$30.00 / month

2019 Municipal Election Qualifications

Resolution #310 of the Town of Clyde Park:

Effective July 1, 1996, all applicants for the position must be a registered voter in Park County, MT & the must have lived in the corporate limits of Clyde Park for not less than one year.

Town of Clyde Park Mayor:

7-4-4301. Qualifications for mayor. (1) A person is not eligible for the office of mayor unless the person:

- (a) is at least 21 years old;
- (b) has been a resident of the state for at least 3 years; and
- (c) has been a resident for at least 2 years preceding the election to office of the city or town or an area that has been annexed by the city or town.
- (2) The office of mayor of a city or town is considered vacant if the individual elected as mayor ceases to be a resident of the city or town

Town of Clyde Town Council Member:

7-4-4401. Qualifications for city council member. A person is not eligible for the office of city council member unless the person is a resident for at least 60 days preceding the election to office of the ward electing the person or of an area that has been annexed by the city or town and placed in the ward.
