In Eastern Zone all burners MUST:

• Notify DEQ prior to ignition

- Obtain a permit from your local fire control authority.
- Check for good ventilation conditions prior to your burn.
- Be aware that permits can be restricted based on fire danger potential by your local fire authority.

Any materials resulting from a salvage operation

Dead animals or dead animal parts

Oil or petroleum products

Food wastes Pathogenic wastes

Treated lumber and timbers Any waste which is moved from the premises where it was generated


Wood and wood byproducts that have been coated, painted, stained, treated, or contaminated

Standing or demolished structures containing prohibited material

Eastern Montana Open Burning Zone: Big Horn, Blaine, Carbon, Carter, Cascade, Chouteau, Custer, Daniels, Dawson, Fallon, Fergus, Garfield, Glacier, Golden Valley, Hill, Judith Basin, Liberty, McCone, Meagher, Musselshell, Park (that portion north of Interstate 90), Petroleum, Phillips, Pondera, Powder River, Prairie, Richland, Roosevelt, Rosebud, Sheridan, Stillwater, Sweet Grass, Teton, Toole, Treasure, Valley, Wheatland, Wibaux, and Yellowstone.
