# MT PARK 63(1) Tom Miner Creek Road Capital Improvements Project

The Tom Miner Creek Road Capital Improvements Project is located approximately 40 miles Southwest of Livingston, Montana in Paradise Valley. The project work consists of removal and replacement of the two deteriorating short span concrete bridges over Tom Miner Creek and Rock Creek. The existing bridges will be replaced with longer and wider GRS-IBS bridges, riprap protection, and guardrail. The project will also include some rehabilitation work on the Carbella Truss Bridge consisting of replacing the existing bridge deck and repairing some of the truss members.



### Current Operations

The Carbella Truss Bridge deck replacement work began this past week. The Contractor has installed a debris containment shield beneath the first section of the bridge and has begun the deck removal work. The metal deck panels are being installed as the deck removal progresses to minimize the exposure of workers to the openings in the bridge deck. **The Carbella Bridge will be closed for the next several weeks for the deck replacement work. Traffic detours are in place along Old Yellowstone Trail South.**

As the river and stream flows begin to decrease work is anticipated to resume on the Tom Miner Bridge replacement within the next few weeks. This work is likely to resume following the fourth of July Holiday.



### Traffic Control



**Carbella Bridge is closed.** Detour and road closure signs are in place directing public traffic to the detour while the bridge is closed. Traffic will be detoured along Old Yellowstone Trail South up to the northern intersection of Old Yellowstone Trail South and Highway 89.
